At Frankston East Primary School, one of our most important commitments is making sure every student experiences high quality teaching, every day, in every classroom. This term, our staff are engaged in dedicated professional learning focused on a shared approach to teaching and learning - one that gives our whole school community a common language and a consistent way of thinking about what great teaching looks like.

What this means in practice is that whether your child is in Prep or Grade 6, they will experience lessons that are clearly structured, where they understand what they are learning and why, where their teacher knows how to respond when they are finding something tricky, and where high expectations are the norm across the school — not just in individual classrooms. Our teachers are working together in teams, sharing their practice, observing each other, and building on what the research tells us works best for students. This is ongoing, purposeful work and we are proud of the commitment our staff bring to it. You may be forgiven for looking at some contemporary classrooms and interpreting what you see as a step back in time. Calmer walls, desks in rows, teacher at the front delivering more structured lessons...children sitting, listening, practising, thinking.

So let us be clear. What you are seeing is not a step backwards. It is a step forwards, informed by what we now understand about how children learn.

We look forward to sharing more about this work with our community as the term progresses.

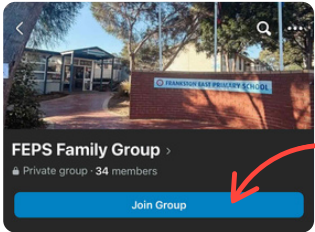
