Reminder from the office:

- To help us get ready for the end of the year, we ask all parents and carers to jump onto Sentral and clean up any **unexplained absences**. You can do this by logging onto the Sentral app, clicking 'absences'. From there it will show you any unexplained absent days and you can submit a reason for the absence.

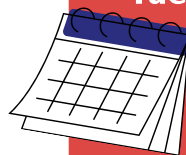

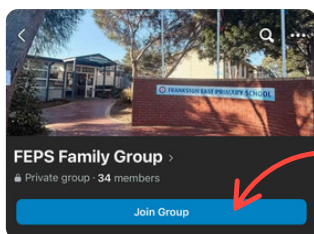
