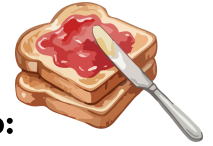

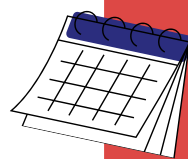

The way you make people feel will always matter more than being the smartest person in the room!

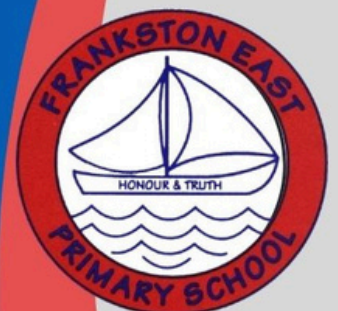

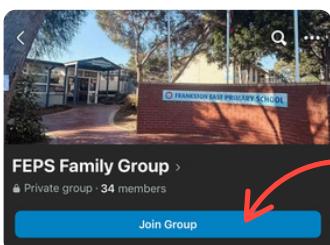
