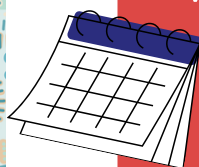

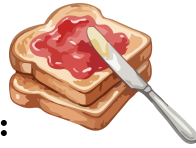

Be kind, be yourself. Don't be afraid to make mistakes and always give things a go. You might just surprise yourself what you can achieve.

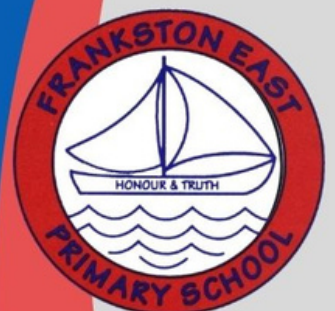

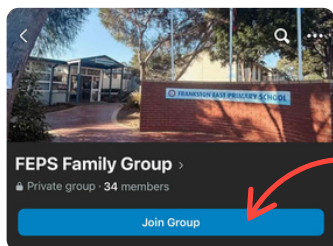
